ST. MARGARET'S-AT-CLIFFE.

St. Margaret's-at-Cliffe lies about three miles north-east from Dover, rather more than a mile off the main road from Dover to Deal and Kingsdown. A service of omnibuses and motor cars ply between Dover and St. Margaret's daily. Martin Hill is the nearest railway station, on the Dover and Deal Railway, two-and-a-half miles distant.
 The church of St. Margaret's is probably one of the finest specimens of Norman work extant.
